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Nima Moghaddam completed his medical school, Internal Medicine, and Cardiology training at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver. He then pursued a fellowship in Advanced Heart Failure and Transplant Cardiology at Duke University in North Carolina with additional training in Cardiac Critical Care. After spending 2 years in the United States for training, he has returned to Canada and accepted an academic position as a HF/Transplant and CICU cardiologist at the University of British Columbia.

His research focus is on acute heart failure, strategies to improve outcomes, medication uptake in hospital, and use mobile health technologies to support transition of patients with acute HF from hospital to community. He also has an interest in advanced heart failure therapies including mechanical circulatory support in cardiogenic shock and has been involved with cardiogenic shock working groups.
